How long oh Lord, do I search for you in the midst of my feelings of sadness? Are you sitting in a season of time when your days roll into nights, and nights into days? When the difficulties of life keep rolling in like waves of the sea? Do you find yourself saying, "Where are you my Lord, my Savior? Why does this darkness cover my soul as a blanket day and night?"

Yes, I have been there. You are not alone. I'd like to share with you how the Lord helped me to walk out of that time.

I was sitting in the waves of sorrow that were rolling in towards me. I went to my husband and he shared with me what he could from the Lord. My husband, basically said, "When you turn it over to the Lord, this time of darkness will end." Well, that's just great, I thought. I could try, but the waves of sadness hit so strong, knocking me from side to side. I didn't even have the ability to think faith. It was as if a person was swimming and the waves kept hitting and hitting. After awhile the shoreline was not in clear sight.

God has His ways to help us. I purchased a cassette by Kenneth Copeland. The tape was full of songs that I hoped would bring me into a state of worship. All of a sudden, as I was listening to the tape, a song came on which confirmed what my husband had shared with me previously and further encouraged me to reach out to the Lord.

The special words in this particular song were "how will it end, look to Him". I played this song over and over to get it into my soul ... sometimes very loud to close out the voices urging me on to wallow in the unhappiness I was feeling.

Jesus said "I will never leave you or forsake you" God says, "See I have engraved you in the palm of my hand".

As I sat in my car, with the rain pouring down on my windshield, and tears streaming down my face, God spoke to me and said "The raindrops on your window are my angels crying for you today". I said, "Oh, God, you have more to say to me, don't you?" I grabbed a pen and some paper of sorts from my purse and proceeded to pen what God spoke to my heart that day:

Herein, began the healing of my soul. The waves became less strong and the faith and love of God started to grow stronger. I remembered Psalm 23 "The Lord is my Shepherd. The Lord is my Shepherd"... sometimes God will only give us a little bit of His word to strengthen us. Remember, "The Lord is my (your) Shepherd" too.

REJOICING IN GOD'S LOVE

I have a great story to tell you. Now you have to understand that I am not a perfect Christian. Are you? If you are, you should think again, for no one is perfect, but Jesus.

Anyway, I have had a very hard time over the past year. I lived in sadness most of the time, struggling with my walk with God, because of the enemy's attack. It was as if every time I got up, I was spun around and punched. Men could relate to this, when I say it was like being in a boxing match, when things really get heated.

God is so good to us, when we don't give up. I felt I was hanging on with a thread somehow attached to God. Many things were attacking my walk with God, so that I would give up on following Him. But, in my deep despair I still called out to God for help and he answered my call.

I had to do some things, like make an effort to seek Him and His Word, yet I couldn't read my bible. I didn't want to sing praises. I didn't want to hear preaching and I didn't want to be around any Christians. That is how deep my despair was. Yet deep inside, I didn't want to walk away from God. Waves of darkness consumed my soul. And fear tried to take hold. When I went to church, a song or a word of preaching spun me into tears of sadness. Needless to say, I was afraid to go to church, because I didn't want to cry any more.

What about my husband? Of course, he tried to share God's wisdom with me. I heard but couldn't apply things and I understood yet, the pull on me became stronger. Mind you, I didn't want to run from God, but I guess I was running away from circumstance and thereby, I also found myself running away from God.

I realized finally, that I had a choice to make. There are always two roads to walk. You walk with God or walk away from Him. After all the blessings I received and the times God has used me to minister to others, I really didn't want to give up my walk with Him.

But sometimes, I am sorry to say, there are people around us that are Christians and yet are not really walking in God's love and wisdom, yet they think they are. These people can really trip you up. I urge you to watch out for them. Keep your walk with God and **Stay in His Word**. Regardless of the circumstances, I tried to listen to Christian music and was blessed from time to time. Then I started to listen to TBN and God started speaking to me through Jan Crouch and her story of depression (great testimony), Kenneth Copeland, Creflo Dollar, Joyce Myers and a minister from Ft. Lauderdale, all of them unbelievably, preached on the same subject ...Get Out of the Boat and walk on the water to Jesus. Just reach out and Jesus will be there for you.

Finally, God's message got through to me and this is what happened. I pray I can express it all properly to you.

I had just listened to pastor Dollar preaching and said, "OK God, I am going in my room and get things in order with you." So I went in my room, took off my shoes and in my heart said, "God I'm coming to you and taking my shoes off like Moses did, so I can walk on Holy Ground." No sooner did I sit down on my bed and put my bible in front of me and prayed, "God I understand your message. I want to come back to you," then I heard a faint cry of a cat (meow) and thought oh, another lost animal. I have to stop for a minute and tell you, not only through my time of sadness did I come across a lot of sad women, but also have helped rescue a few dogs and a cat. Almost every other week, when I would go out, I would see a lost dog... at least 5 in the past month. We don't live in the wilderness. There are many homes here so where were they coming from? There are so many lost people and animals.

To go on with what happened, I started to speak to God again, but I heard another cry of a cat (meow, meow). "Oh it's my cat. He must be shut up in the closet by accident." Sure enough, it was my cat Sammy that I heard crying, and of course, I rescued him from his dilemma.

My two dogs came running in and jumped on the bed to see what was happening. They were rejoicing with me and began kissing Sammy, my cat too. Why am I telling you this story? Where does God fit into this? Well, let me tell you the most remarkable thing.

The preacher I was listening to said, "Jesus has His hand reaching out to you. All you have to do is reach back and you can walk on the water with Him and get out of the storm."

God revealed to me that since I reached out to Him with understanding and made an effort to follow Him, He was already there for me and was rejoicing that I had come back home to Him. Now let me tell you the funniest thing. God has a sense of humor and also uses things we can understand to understand Him. While I was rejoicing on getting Sammy, my cat, out of the darkness of the closet, God was showing me in my spirit how He was rejoicing over me, that I chose to reach out to Him and He was taking me out of my closet of darkness. God's word from the bible to me at that time was, Luke 19:10 "For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost."

My two dogs, God showed me, were rejoicing and wondering what was going on and kissing Sammy, my cat, was a picture of God's angels rejoicing with Him ...that I had come back home to God. I laughed and laughed and laughed, how God could use this circumstance to show me His joy and now I found myself rejoicing and laughing with God. Not only did God show me all this joy but He also allowed me a little of how much joy He had over me on my return. He did this every time I touched Sammy. A tremendous amount of joy would flow through me and God kept saying to my spirit, **"This is joy I feel for you".** Every time I touched my dogs, God allowed me to feel some of what He feels when He touches His Angels. God and me, laughed for the longest of time and joy returned back to my soul (mind, will and emotions).

The next thing that happened was, that my dogs and I went out in the backyard and they ran and ran and ran with lots of life streaming in abundance. And as I rejoiced in the backyard, thanking God, He spoke to my spirit again and said, "Life streams from Me. There is an abundance of life in My world."

II Corinthians 3:5 says..."Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being of ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God." And Psalms 66:5 says, "Come and see the works of God: He is awesome in His doing toward the sons of men."

The last scripture the Lord shared with me was Psalms 16:7..." Return to your rest oh my soul for the Lord has dealt bountifully with you."

Are you thankful for what God has done for you? Have you been seeking His direction, your own or someone else's?

Faith Is the Substance

I would like to share a teaching that the Lord gave me on Faith. Faith is the substance of things hoped for. Now, realize that you can have faith in the good things of God or faith in bad things that are not of God. The word, "substance" means – standing under the claim. The claim to the property supports its validity. Thus, faith is a title deed, your right to have and use. You may have hope, but you have nothing of substance to stand on: use faith. It is your substance.

Here's a question for you: How can you have faith if you don't hear God's Word or read His Word? As we know, "Faith comes by hearing and hearing from the Word of God". Look to God for a revelation from His Word to you, and then stand on it.

Let's look at a few scriptures, these will show us that it wasn't the faith that Jesus had that healed someone, but the faith the person had that reached out to Him that healed them. It's like a plug and a socket. Put them together and you get a flow of electricity. Your faith in Jesus and the faith that is in Him couples together and you have a divine flow.

Matthew 9:29 "Then touched he (Jesus) their eyes saying, According to your faith, be it unto you." Matthew 9:22 "But Jesus turned him about and when he saw her, he said, "**Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith has made thee whole."** Matthew 8:10 "When Jesus heard it, he marveled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel." (with anyone)

Matthew 9:2 "Behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus, seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee." Let's see what is in your title deed, as I mentioned above. Take a look at Hebrews. This is where the Lord showed me how to walk in faith.

Hebrews 11:3 "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that **things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.**" Hebrews 11:4 – Shows us that we need to offer obedience and sacrifice to God.

Hebrews 11:5 - Please God – How? By taking God at His word.

Hebrews 11:6 - Seek God diligently, and believe He is a re-warder of them that diligently seek him.

How can you walk in faith? God showed me by reading through Hebrews 11.

If we look at the following, we will see a flow and application for walking in faith.

HEBREWS 11:7 – "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear" Notice Noah was TOLD of God.

HEBREWS 11:8 – Abraham by faith was called of God to go out into a place and he OBEYED, not knowing where he went. – You OBEY God's direction

HEBREWS 11:9 – "By faith he (Abraham) sojourned in the land of promise." Abraham made a move. MOVE in your circumstance based on what God tells you.

HEBREWS 11:11 – "Through faith also Sara herself RECEIVED strength to conceive seed" Your part is to RECEIVE by faith what God shows you.

HEBREWS 11:17 – "By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac; and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten."

Your part is to LAY DOWN YOUR CIRCUMSTANCE TO GOD, FOR HIM TO RAISE UP. You leave it in God's hands. What else do you do?

When I read HEBREWS 11:20-25, I saw that I would be blessed. I should be thankful and sing praise and worship to God. I should also depart from the situation, not sit in fear and refuse to accept the circumstance or situation. I need then, to remember that I left the care in God's hands to work out.

As I read further in Hebrews 11:26-31 this is what was revealed to me:

- 1. I should hold up the riches, blessings of God higher than the benefits of what others can give me or sin can give to me.
- 2. I should leave the situation and don't fear but trust God.

- 3. I should keep my walk with God and pass through or move over to the New Life in my situation.
- 4. I will then see the walls fall down concerning this problem and everlasting life will be shed in that situation.

These are the 11 RULES OF FAITH that God shared with me.

- 1. YOU ARE TOLD OF GOD
- 2. YOU OBEY GOD
- 3. YOU MOVE IN GOD
- 4. YOU RECEIVE OF GOD
- 5. YOU WALK IN THE BLESSING
- 6. YOU WORSHIP GOD
- 7. YOU LEAVE SIN
- 8. YOU LEAVE THE PLACE OR SITUATION
- 9. YOU WALK IN NEW LIFE (pass thru)
- 10. YOU SEE OLD WALLS FALL DOWN
- 11. YOU HAVE EVERLASTING LIFE IN THE SITUATION (victory)

The last two things I want to share with you are the last two scriptures that were given to me, as I sought the Lord that day.

I Peter 3:12 "For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil."

I Peter 2:9 "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." Called chosen, called to show forth praises in every situation.

I pray you have been blessed, encouraged not to give up and that you gain many victories by standing on God's Word that are His promise's, just for you.

Then, take a stand Matthew 16:23 "Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men." More drops of water as you stand upon the Word of God.

Matthew 16:25,26 "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?" The soul is our mind, will and emotions. What will we gain if we gain our quest for money, fame, and power but lose our mind, will and emotional stability in the process?

Luke 12:7 "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: you are of more value than many sparrows." Remember, don't fear but stand in faith for you are more valuable than not one, but many sparrows.

John 6:63 "It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing the words that I speak (Jesus) unto you, they are spirit, and they are life." Jesus' words of truth bring life to us.

Colossians 3:16 "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." Colossians 3:8

"Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ." Keep your mind on the words of God, on good things, and don't let anyone who is full of deceit and vanity sway you with their philosophy or you will find yourself still in a dry thirsty place.

Why then do you feel that you are a thirsty dry land where there is not water? Jeremiah 8:5 "Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back (turned away) by a perpetual backsliding? They hold fast deceit, they refuse to return." What a word from the Lord. You find yourself not able to go on because you stay in deceit about your situation.

"Many suffer if a man brings you into bondage, or if a man devours you, if a man takes of you, if a man exalts himself, or if a man hits you on the face." This is a reference to II Corinthians 11:20. You sit with no strength.

Ephesians 6:10 "Put on the whole Armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles (trick or lies) of the devil." Ephesians 6:11 "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." Stand in truth, righteousness, the gospel of peace, your shield of faith, salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.

Isaiah 40:29-31 "He gives power to the faint; and to them that have no might, he increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall utterly fall: BUT they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

Isaiah 41:17 "When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the Lord will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them." Standing on the words and truths of God will refresh and strengthen you. When you are in need, God will hear you and He will not turn away from you. You should not give up and give in, but look to God and He will lift you up and be there for you.

My Soul Longs For Thee

God, my soul longs for Thee in a dry and thirsty land.

Psalm 63:1 "O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;"

This is the beginning of Psalm 63. A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah.

How are you doing these days? Does your mind and emotions scream out saying God, I am thirsty, God, I am dry? David felt the same way. What to do?

The 1st verse stated above shows us that the first thing David did was to acknowledged God; he is truthful with God and states who God is to him. "Thou art my God."

Verse 2 "To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary."

Notice David was not anywhere near a sanctuary. He was alone.

Let's jump over to Psalm 42:1-3 "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God. My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God? My tears have been my meat day and night, while they continually say unto me, where is thy God? "

Do you ever feel so terribly alone? Perhaps, there is no church to go to, or other Christians around you that can comfort you. Are you in a desert place in your life? Have you been finding that others are wondering where God is in your state of affairs? Are you ever finding yourself crying out day and night? I believe all of us find ourselves in that type of circumstance sometime in our life. Let's not give up hope....hope thou in God. Let's see what decision David made and learn from him.

Verse 3 of Psalm 63 ... "Because thy loving kindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee."

My goodness... David decided to praise God in the mist of his circumstance. "I praise you Lord, I praise you Lord." Even better, why not

give a sacrifice of praise in song? Oh, you are probably saying, forget it, I don't want to sing. How could you ask me to sing now when I feel so dry and thirsty? Well, let's not forget that, "God inhabits the praises of His people." We can sing and praise God and He will show up for us.

Psalm 63:verse 4..."Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name."

Can you see David making this decision and statement and lifting up his hands to God?

Why did he decide to do this? What was his purpose? Look at verse 5..."My soul (mind, will and emotions) shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:"

When is David intending to do all this? Verse 6 ... "When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches."

Well, it looks to me like every time he remembers God during the day and even through the night, David will be praising God. How about you? How about me? Sounds good to me. It says in the bible, **"Don't give place to the devil."** I guess this would be a really good way to keep your eyes on God.

Why is David doing all this anyway? Verse 7 ... "Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice."

Oh, look at that, David is reflecting on the times God had been there for him and drawing strength from past victories. Also, he says, "In the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice." Psalm 91:4...."He (God) shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler." God's truth in your situation shall be a shield to you.

The last verse I will share with you is verse 8. "My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me." David now is confessing hope in his situation.

To sum it all up... when we find ourselves in a dry and thirsty place, we need to turn to God. Get under the shadow of His wings and seek God's truth in your situation. Have church any time you think on God, if during the day or at night or both. Just start to praise Him, lift up your hands to Him, and thank Him for all He has done and what He will do for you.

Jesus said, "I will never leave you or forsake you." One of the Old Testament prophets gave a "thus sayeth the Lord", saying ... "But, cleave unto the Lord your God, as ye have done unto this day. For the Lord hath driven out from before you great nations and strong but as for you no man hath been able to stand before you unto this day. One man of you shall chase a thousand for the Lord your God, he it is that fighteth for you, as he hath promised you. Take heed therefore, unto yourselves that you love the Lord your God."

Cowering in fear behind the mattress, I prayed. "Jesus help calm the storm, protect me."

"Jesus you calmed the storm in the bible story I read. Please do it now for me."

The roof of her home was damaged that the house across the street where we had lived was affected as well. God's protection was there for our home because I stood on God's Word.

Since that time, they now say that the safest side of the basement is the Southeast not the Southwest. Goes to show you, you can't rely on man. It's better to be obedient to God's direction for your life.

Well, maybe you got a little chuckle out of my experience. But, what about your concerns, doubts and fears? How are you handling it? God's word says, "I have not given you a spirit of fear, but of power and love and a sound mind." His word says, "Speak to the mountain to be removed and cast into the sea and not doubt in your heart but believe."

Your obedience to what God shows you to do does not only help you but others around you. If I hadn't been obedient to what Jesus told me to do, in the midst of the storm, my home could have been destroyed. I could have been destroyed and my animals in the home also. Romans 8:12-39 "Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if you live after the flesh, you shall die: but if you through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, you shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For you have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ: if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. For I reckon that the suffering of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory, which shall be revealed in us.

For the earnest expectation of the creature waits for the manifestation of the sons of God. Miracles Still Happen

One of my bones in my back had moved out of place and was hitting upon a nerve and damaging it. My muscles in my neck, shoulder and back area were frozen. The chiropractor that had caused this had checked me out and told me I was all right. But, his masseuse told me there was a bone out of place. Well, I was a mess. I had another appointment with a new chiropractor. It was going to take a few weeks because he was on vacation.

I prayed and sought the Lord. I applied the Word of God concerning healing and thanked the Lord for His healing touch. As the days passed, I was in a lot of pain. One morning I woke up and remembered I once read in a Kenneth Copeland magazine that I need to receive my healing. So while lying in bed that morning, as I awoke in pain, I said out loud, "I receive my healing right now in the name of Jesus." I meant it with all I had in me.

No sooner did I say it, a sharp pain went through my back where the bone had been out of place. I felt the bone move back into place. When I went to the new chiropractor, he took an x-ray of my back. My bone was not out of place. God showed me in His Word that He would renew me like the noonday and the morning and that He would strengthen me. It took seven months for me to feel normal again. Remember the man and the dollar bill with the sevens on it, which meant perfection. God had perfected me in 7 months. My miracle had taken place. God shared many scriptures with me throughout these seven months. I stood on new words from God each day. The one that I stood on first was **"Daughter your faith has made you whole. Go in peace and be healed of this plague."** Let God's Word be true. No one knew but God, what had really happened to me.

God also answered a prayer about meeting Oral Roberts. My shoulder was still freezing up on me, no matter how many massages I would have. My faithful husband massaged me everyday and the massage therapist would came every other week or so. Oral Roberts was to speak at a local church and we went to see him. After Oral Roberts gave his message he said, "I don't understand this but God is telling me that someone here has a frozen shoulder and He is healing you. Will you stand up;" That was me. After that day my shoulder never froze up again. Praise God.

There are so many great things God has done for me. I could write a book on them alone.

Let me tell you what happened to a lady who was going to a small ladies fellowship. She had some work done on several veins in her legs. She had some complications and now was faced with going back to the doctor again. She really was dreading the visit. She had asked the woman who had ministered that day to pray for her. The woman told her that when she prayed earlier in the meeting for another lady, it was also for her.

The Lord spoke to me and told me I needed to pray for her. Lord, I said, I have a headache and want to go home. If you really want me to pray for Cindy then let us meet somehow. Well I proceeded to leave the home and as I did Cindy got up from the couch and wound up right in front of me. I said, "Cindy do you want me to pray for you?" Two years later, I ran into this same woman at a Christian Ladies meeting. She remembered me...grabbed me and said, I remember you. 
Romans12:2 "And be not conformed to this world; but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

Where is the anointing at worship time? Who is in charge of the music at your church? Are they someone who plays the piano better than anyone else or can lead music? But are they truly anointed of God to lead others into the throne room of God?

Where is your minister really? If you find yourself saying, well one day he will be a really good minister, then why are you sitting under his teaching? Did they say that about Moses? Or Jesus????? Isn't a minister supposed to be seasoned in the Word and in his relationship with God? Check it out in the bible. **The answer is yes.**

What denomination are you? Oh my, really, you mean you really believe that? We all have been taught differently, yet there is one thread that binds us and that is the true meaning of salvation and the trinity. What denomination are you? I was asked after I was saved and you know what, I couldn't tell you. Why? Because I accepted the Lord in my living room and read and read my bible and applied His Word to my life. God didn't tell me, "You are now of this denomination." He welcomed me into His family and loved me. Denominational choices are yours to make. Make them wisely and with some knowledge from God in His Word.

Do you know what the anointing in church should be? Or.... Are you just going along with others? "Oh the anointing is so strong. Don't you feel it?" as this is announced from the pulpit or music minister. "Do you feel it?????? Well, do you???" The anointing is a touch from God and you will know it when He touches you. You won't be overtaken in the frenzy of the music. Instead, you will be touched by the words and music as the Holy Spirit ministers to your soul. You may cry, rejoice, be ministered to by the words, be healed, and yes, even slain in the Spirit. Only an anointed individual or individuals playing the music can usher in the presence of God, not people that can play extremely well and get you in frenzy.

Why aren't you sitting in a bible study? I have been asked that a number of times. First of all, I have been in a bible study for 22 years, sitting at the master's feet, reading the Word of God and applying it in my life. I am also a Rhema Graduate. Why have I left some bible studies? Because there have been a number of people teaching that weren't teaching at all. Their focus was to socialize and just skim over some teaching. No one was leaving edified. One bible study I was in, the teacher who was the pastor's son, just made a lot of jokes about everything. He turned out to be backslidden and after ministering to him, he went back a stronger Christian and serious about the study. The other long time bible study students couldn't make fun anymore. They had to get serious or leave.

Let me share a story about another women's group that I had attended. The teacher, leading the class, by letting everyone give answers but she never gave the bible answers. She just allowed everyone to believe what they wanted. She had a big class and people came for years. Why? I believe these folks never opened their bible to see what the Word had to say. Why else would they go to such an unfruitful class? Socialize? Be careful from whom you receive teaching. Just because someone says they are a bible teacher, check it out a little further and be smart.

Don't stay away from church or bible study. Always stay in the Word. God will always, through the Holy Spirit, teach you and guide you and give you the answers sometimes others cannot. Or you may not want to share something with others because they may not understand and could lead you astray. But, you can always count on Jesus and His Word. You will know when the bible study or pastor's teaching is right. Check it out with the bible itself. Read before and after scriptures that have been shared to get a full meaning of what is being taught. Sometimes pastors will take them out of contexts to make their point but the point is wrong, at least

with that scripture(s). Study the Word. We are told to do so in the bible itself.

Don't let others keep you bound in fear that you are not worthy or lack the knowledge. Let God open the doors for you and rejoice in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart. Again I say rejoice, for your heavenly Farther knows what you need. He will never leave you or forsake you. He will stick closer to you than a brother.

Remember, confusion is not of God. Don't be swayed by crowds going in one direction, because, Jesus may be leading you in another.

"Why are thou disquieted oh my soul, hope though in God."

Thank you God for bringing me out of confusion and filling me with knowledge from your throne on high, for I was lost but now I am found. I was blind but now I see.

Be strong and in the power of His might and He will lift you up, for there is healing in His wings. It is not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit sayeth the Lord.

"For though your times were tough and hard and many stones were in your path, I have found you and held your hand and strengthen you in my love. So do not fear or fret or strain within your soul", says the Lord.

What I have observed from our dogs is the excitement they express related to the questions that I ask them. They look and wonder, "Are we going with you today?" Or "Do we stay home?" If I say, "Want to go for a walk or a ride in the van? They jump with joy and run all over the house barking and barking, running and leaping with excitement and joy. If they see me get dressed and I don't say a word, they wonder and hang around just waiting for the words ride or walk. If I say, "I'm going to the store", they just look as if to say, "Oh all right, guess we are not going anywhere." They don't realize they are better off at home but they respect me anyway. But when I do tell them to come with me, they are protected by me, even if they think they have it all together.

Why are you telling me about your dogs? Isn't this supposed to be a teaching on my relationship with God? Well, keep your shirt on.

How many times do you find yourself praying and seeking God for a way? Which way should I precede in a situation? Why is it that though, with all my heart, I want to go this way, yet you show me in your Word and prayer time that I must stay put? How many times has God told you to do something and you stayed put and should have moved on? Or, you moved on when God told you to stay put?

I heard a teaching on Elisha. When God told him to go by the brook Cherith and the ravens would bring him food. He needed to stay beside a brook so that water would be available to him. (I Kings 17:1-4) Don't you think he would have rather been in a nice cozy comfortable spot that was familiar? What was going to happen to him anyway sitting by the brook? But he stayed right there. He had just prophesied to Ahab and told him that a drought would come. Guess what? God placed Elisha in the right spot where he could find water so he wouldn't thirst and food would be delivered to him twice a day by ravens.

Elisha could have complained and said, this is not a good enough provision, God. But, he had time to rest and relax and the stream of water was there any time he needed a drink. The ravens were his servants, bringing him food everyday. What a time. Wouldn't you like to relax and be served? So what if the servants looked like birds, who cares?

And there at the brook, Elisha sat no friends, no TV, nothing but the sound of the brook and nature all around him. After the brook dried up, Elisha was told of God to leave that place and go and see a widow lady for his provision. (I Kings 17:9) And so Elisha obeyed and was provided food and water once again. Remember there was a drought throughout the land. But, God took care of Elisha and when the widow woman helped, she also was taken care of.

What if Elisha was stubborn and didn't want the provisions God had provided for him?

How about, if he responded with anger, hostility, complaining and just flat refused the provisions of God. He would have found himself hungry, thirsty, very sad and probably would have died. Instead he found peace, wasn't thirsty, was fed, even when the brook dried up, God still provided for him. But he had to obey and not rely on what he wanted to do. So, Elisha still went on and was taken care of and helped others along the way and blessed them.

When my puppy dogs, Maggie and Buddy, obey what I ask them to do, they also find provisions. Their water is always available, they always have food, and they are always sitting under the protection of my love. If they didn't, they would wander off on their own, searching for something to eat and something to drink, never finding peace and always searching for comfort and love. As we all know, everyone that they would come across would not treat them so kindly. After all, there are many dangers out there. Good thing they have learned to obey me and respect me. Then they will be protected, provided for and loved. Who wouldn't want to have that? By the way, my dog Buddy just loves watching T.V., especially Animal Planet. He just sits there in an overstuffed chair with his front paws crossed and doesn't have a care in the world. Why? Because, he knows in whom he believes, trusts me and feels safe. I wonder what he is watching right now. Maybe I'd better go look. It could be something good like "Breed All About It", or "Miracle Babies".

Well, how much more will our Father God take care of us if we will seek Him and heed His voice. When God says, **"WALK"** then we walk. When He says, **"STAY"**, then we stay. And when He says, **"COME"**, then we come. All the time knowing we are in His care, love and protection.

Whatever went wrong, God shows us that He has not forgotten us and that He will make provisions for us just like Elisha. As long as we reach out for God, He will not leave us or forsake us. But, instead, He will provide what we need at the time.

Let's look further into what God did for Elisha. There was Elisha feeling beaten, fearful, and seemingly totally alone and forgotten. Then there was God reaching out to him with mercy, grace, forgiveness, care, provision and rest.

Can't you just see Elisha sitting by the brook; the quietness of nature all around him; the stillness of the day, relaxing? Or was he being strengthened in his walk with God, ever growing and being refreshed. Just as the water from the brook refreshes his thirst, so God refreshed Elisha with living water. And the food provided for Elisha was brought to him. Elisha could rest. He didn't have to worry about going to hunt for food. He could just take his ease and rest until his strength and confidence was regained once again and his spirit was filled with faith once more to serve God and bless others.

I have been experiencing that kind of walk. Have you? If not, some time in the future you just might. What will you do? Run, Run, Run or reach out to God for His counsel and help? And when God provides for you, will you find yourself saying something like, "Well, did you have to put me by myself by a brook, stream, lake, beach, etc. and why can't I get the best food at the best stores? Why do I have to go to these local stores where there are just a few people shopping? Why can't I go to the bigger stores to shop for food where many people are?" Let's look again at Elisha sitting by the brook being taken care of by God. What else was happening? His enemy Jezebel was after him to take his life. But, God took care of that situation while Elisha rested and was restored. Sometimes we want to fight all the battles and yet God says rest, sit back, relax, I will fight for you and move your enemies out of the way.

When we look more closely at Elisha's situation, we see that when the brook dried up, he also was ready with strength in himself and in his relationship with God to go on with his life. God then directed him to a widow woman. She sat with her son, ready to give up her life and his, because of the drought. Elisha shows up at her house with what? Have you guessed it yet?

Elisha showed up with his strength and his new refreshed walk with God and the anointing and Word of God in him. To do what?... To do for the widow woman what was done for him by God. He first asked her to obey his direction to have faith in him. He then provided for them through God's power. The woman and her son experienced what Elisha had experienced, the provisions of God and hope to go on in life.

Don't you think God can do that for you? Don't you think you have a part to play in someone else's life? It is like a chain reaction. So don't resist when God provides for you in ways that you might not understand. Look around! Are you being provided the rest you need, yet yearning to run, run, run? Take your rest. Be assured that God has not forgotten you. Then you will find yourself filled with the strength of God to go on and be a blessing to others.

Well, God certainly has encouraged me with this teaching. I hope you have been encouraged as well.

Are You Walking In Faith or Under The Law?

Galatians 3:2 "This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?" This is the first question God asked me as I sought Him just recently.

The second question was Galatians 3:3 "Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now made perfect by the flesh?"

Galatians 3:5 is the third question He asked me. "He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?"

God continued to speak to me through His word Galatians 3:6-9 "Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham." And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, "In thee shall all nations be blessed." So then they, which be of faith, are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Notice what Galatians 3:10 says, "For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them." What about Galatians 3:11 & 12? "But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, the just shall live by faith. And the law is not of faith: but, the man that doeth them shall live in them."

The importance of walking in faith is more than we realize. We all seem to say yes we are walking in faith but are we? Let's go on and see what else God showed me.

Galatians 3: 22-26 "But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith, which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus."

I would hope, as you can see by now, it is only through faith in Jesus that we are children of God and not because of our works. Where are we going with all this you may be asking? We are to examine ourselves by what God just showed us. Are you trying to live up to others expectations in church, at bible study, or at any other meeting of a Christian nature? Know that when you accepted Jesus and gave your life to Him that it was by faith not of works. Where are you today? Have you found yourself hindered by others in the Christian community? The following is a question to us from God.

Galatians 5:7 & 8 "Ye did run well; who did hinder you that you should not obey the truth? This persuasion (belief) comes not of him that called you."

Galatians 5:9 "A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump."

Have you been walking in the Spirit by faith and someone or many others have, because of their persuasions, caused you to trip up and start walking in the flesh? Or shall I say challenged your authority and caused you to question your walk with the Lord, thereby, causing you to stumble and try to explain how important you are? A little doubt can cause more doubt until you find yourself in the flesh. Leaven is like putting yeast in the dough when making bread. It looks real small but enough of it will cause the dough to rise.

Yet, God has a word of encouragement in Galatians 5:10 "I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be."

Get away from or do not give place to those that would question your faith in God and try to put you on a spot in an effort to pull you into the flesh and under the law.

Remember Galatians 5:16 "This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."

Ephesians 4:17-19 "This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, Having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart. Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness."

Though a person is a Christian, they can still be walking in the vanity of their mind. Their understanding can still be darkened. That is not what God wants. It says, in the bible that we are to try the Spirits to see if they be of God.

See? There is a way out of this dilemma. You do not have to walk around questioning whether others around you accept you or not. You are accepted in Christ through faith and not of works. God can do more things through you as you walk in faith with Him than can be accomplished through all the works one can do.

A final reminder: Romans 8:14-21 "So that they that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his."

Why should we walk by faith? <u>First</u>, we are saved through our faith in Jesus, <u>secondly</u>, II Corinthians 5:7 says, "For we walk by faith, not by sight." <u>Finally</u>, We can conclude that there is hope for us to go on walking in faith not by law.

Romans 8:14-21 "For you have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cay, Abba, Farther." The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him that we may be also glorified together. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."

Hallelujah! We can go on because we realize that our faith in Jesus and walking by faith keeps us free from the bondage of the law. So when someone tries to question your positioning or your walk with the Lord, you can say...I have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear... that I do not live up to your expectations. My expectation is from God. As long as I walk with Him in faith then I have all the acknowledgement I need, thank you.

Even more, God wants us to know Romans 8:19 "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly; but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope, Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God."

The animals are looking for the manifestation of us to walk in faith so that they can also be blessed. So come on, what do you say? Let's get out from under the bondage of the law and walk by Faith.

Unbelief

What manner of man is this that calms the wind and sea? Why just by His hand, He plans my destiny. Unwilling to see past what I could see, I sit in loneliness, never feeling free.

But, when I feel His loving touch, I know, I know...That I can trust beyond the portals of my eyes.I see beyond the midnight skies to a place where heaven is.I see His mercy and grace unfold beyond what I can see.

Yet, in my life there is a stillness, That blocks my heart to sing. The misunderstanding of His grace, Has caused my heart to lean upon the things I see,

Unable to let the healing begin, I fall down upon my knee. I find myself praying, lost in heartache and despair. What has happened to my song in the night? Why has the stillness of my soul taken flight?

Have I been to the end of my rainbow? Has darkness engulfed my soul? When misunderstandings take the place of faith, and trust and belief, The saddened soul takes hold and leads us down paths yet untold. Yet, in a second, a glance of light comes streaming towards my soul.

> A remembrance of His faithful love, With yet more stories untold. My saddened heart awakens from sleep And I arise with healing in my wings.

Yet, repentance of my lonely soul now must be. Shadowed in darkness, I awake as if from a dream. My souls screams with an awakening of truth. Where is the God of my yesterday?

How was it that I went astray?

II Corinthians 3:17 "Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (freedom)."

In Jeremiah 10:10-12 God let's us know who He is. He is the true God; he made the earth, by His power, wisdom and discretion. In Jeremiah 9:23-24... We are told not to glory in our wisdom, might or riches.

Isaiah 60:1-3 encourages us to arise and shine. That God's light has come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon us. Also, that His glory shall be seen on you.

Therefore, our confession should be:

Micha 7: 7 & 8 "Therefore I will look unto the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me. (Resurrection Power)...Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord shall be a light unto me."

Praise God! We Win...

Can you do it? Yes. Will you do it? If you do, you will gain your peace back. Praise God.

Isaiah 42:6 "I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles;"

Behold the former things are come to pass....

Isaiah 43:21 "This people have I formed for myself; they shall shew forth my praise."

Isaiah 45:12-13 "I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded. I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, not for price nor reward, saith the Lord of hosts."

Isaiah 45:20 "Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, ye that are escaped of the nations: they have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven image, and pray unto a god that cannot save."

Isaiah 49:16 "Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of my hands; thy walls are continually before me."

Isaiah 53:9-10 "Break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places of Jerusalem: for the Lord hath comforted his people, he hath redeemed Jerusalem. The Lord hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God."

- ✤ No weapon formed against us can keep us away from God's love.
- ✤ We are to shine with His glory as a result of His great love for us.

Chapter 27 It's Time To Move On

It was really important to know that God cared so much for me. I know He will be there for you as you seek Him in your life.

How do we get through tough times?

- ✤ By trusting in the Lord.
- By having faith that He will be there for you.
- By repenting and forgiving others.
- By confessing the promises of God.
- By standing on the Word of God.
- By not falling under the expectations of others.
- By listening for and obeying the voice of the Lord in the circumstance.
- By not giving any place to the devil.
- By praising the Lord in the circumstance, not for what is happening, but rather for His awesome power and willingness to be there with you and lead you to victory.
